- **Alexander Foundation** - Provides financial assistance to ensure the well being and personal growth of individuals in the GLBT community. (303) 331-7733
- **ARTS Outpatient Services** – Outpatient substance abuse treatment for HIV-positive clients. Individual, family, and group counseling. (303) 355-1014
- **Brother Jeff's** – Enhance the quality of life for African Americans living with HIV and AIDS. Support groups, workshops, and prevention with positives. (303) 293-8879
- **CAP** – Colorado's largest community-based HIV and AIDS service agency. Bilingual case management, mental health, substance abuse, support groups, food bank, housing, transportation, and financial assistance. (303) 837-0166
- **CHIP** – Children's Hospital pediatric HIV clinic serving HIV-positive women of childbearing age and infants through 24 years old. (303) 764-8233
- **Colorado Anti-Violence Project** – Serves GLBT victims of domestic violence, bias-motivated, sexual assault, law enforcement and random violence. (303) 839-5204
- **GLBT Services Center** - Support services, social activities, cultural events, youth services program, and legal referrals for the GLBT community. (303) 733-7743
- **Denver Indian Health and Family Services** - Services include dental, optical, and medical assistance, mental health, substance abuse, and victim's services. (303) 781-4050
- **Empowerment Program** – Women's AIDS Project. Case management, support groups, substance abuse, transportation, employment, GED, and housing assistance. (303) 320-1989
- **Gender Identity Center** – Provides support to those people who cross dress, are transsexual, or are non-traditional in their gender identity. (303) 202-6466
- **It Takes a Village** – Programs provide support, education, assistance and prevention case management for HIV-positive African Americans. (303) 367-4747
- **HCBS -PLWA** – Colorado Medicaid program designed as an alternative to nursing facility placement or hospital care for persons living with AIDS. (303) 866-3058
- **Hep-C Connection** – Up-to-date medical information, support groups, newsletters, printed materials and educational services on HIV/HCV co-infection. (720) 917-3970
- **HIV Care Link** – Christian outreach committed to empowering and supporting those affected by HIV. Support groups, help with yard work, painting, moving, etc. (303) 382-1344

- **Legal Center** – Providing legal representation, advocacy and technical assistance to individuals who have experienced discrimination due to HIV/AIDS. (303) 722-0300
- **MHCD / Living with HIV** – Mental health care and support for HIV-positive persons, caregivers, family, and children. (303) 504-6649
- **Mi Casa** – Outreach, prevention, educational services, and resource center. Targets women between the ages of 14 to 29. (303) 573-1302
- **Partner Notification** – Confidentially inform partners who have been exposed to HIV infection. Link at risk people to prevention, care and treatment. (303) 692-2700
- **Planned Parenthood** – Testing and treatment for STDs, yearly exams, pap smears, pregnancy testing, prenatal care, birth control, and more. (303) 832-5069
- **POCCAA** – People of Color Consortium that offers referrals, food bank, transportation and housing assistance. (303) 321-7965
- **PWACC** – Empowering people living with HIV/AIDS through education and advocacy. Home of the “Denver Buyer’s Club.” (303) 329-9379
- **Project Safe** – HIV prevention services and substance treatment for HIV-positive drug injectors and crack smokers. (303) 315-0950
- **Rainbow House** - Run by Volunteers of America. Is the only known daycare facility in the region specifically working to meet the needs of families living with HIV/AIDS
- **Sevicios De La Raza** – Linguistically and culturally proficient HIV/AIDS service program dedicated to the needs of the Latino community. (303) 458-5851
- **Social Security** – Coordinates pay benefits (SSI, Medicare, SSDI) to eligible persons. 800-772-1213
- **Urban Peak** – Targeting runaway, homeless, and at-risk youth under 21. Shelter, food, clothing, counseling, substance abuse, and medical care. (303) 777-9198
